Directions:

From Bury St Edmunds

- Follow the A134 to Sudbury
- Turn Left onto the A1141 to Lavenham
- Continue through to Lavenham High Street, turn left past the Swan to continue on the A1141 towards Brent Eleigh, Monks Eleigh and Bildeston
- Follow this road through to the village of Monks Eleigh
- Continue on the A1141 towards Hadleigh, the road bends around to the right over a small bridge and you will see Bridge Barn Farm shops on your left. As the road bends around to the left up a small hill you will see Lindsey Road on your right hand side. Take this road towards Boyton Hall.
- Continue straight on this road for about 1 mile – DO NOT FOLLOW SAT NAV
- Follow the road, Boyton Hall is on your right hand side

From Hadleigh

- Take A1141 'Stone Street' towards Lavenham A1141/ Stowmarket B1115
- You will go up a steep hill, at the top turn left to stay on the A1141
- Go past Hollow Trees farm shop on your left hand side
- As the road opens up you will see a left hand turn sign posted Lindsey - take this road
- At the bottom of the hill as the road turns sharply left you will see a track on the right - take this track towards Boyton Hall
- Follow track, and turn right when you reach the road at the end.

The lorry and trailer entrance is on your left hand side. Follow this driveway past the arenas and to the Lorry Park where you can park.

Please continue past the main yard gates and past the Boyton Hall Shop, the lorry and trailer entrance is on your right hand side. Follow this driveway past the arenas and to the Lorry Park where you can park.

Withdrawals/Refunds

Health and Safety

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety to everyone present. For the measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.

Terms & Conditions

You agree to:

All entries must be accompanied with the appropriate fees, paid either by BACS, cash or cheque (made payable to 'Boyton Hall Arena Limited').

All Dressage competitions shall run under British Dressage rules, unless stated otherwise.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without reason, to cancel or alter any class, section or competition as they see fit without giving reason. Classes may be split if entries warrant.

The judge's and organisers decision is final. Any objections must be lodged with the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident and supported by a £25 deposit, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.

Boyton Hall Arena Limited, the organisers, their representatives or helpers do not accept liability for injury, damage or loss suffered by spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends, vehicles or property, however caused, and under any circumstances, except proven negligence of the organisers. Claims for negligence against the organisers must be submitted in writing on the day of competition.

All competitors must compete in the declared order.

The welfare and health of all horses attending any event is paramount. Any horse deemed to be sick or injured in any way will be immediately eliminated and the owner shall be asked to remove the horse from the venue. All horses must be no younger than 4 years old.

It is the competitors responsibility to contact the organiser on 07557 091008 to confirm if the event has been cancelled, however status updates will be available from Boyton Hall Monks Eleigh facebook page

Lunging is not permitted.

Entries in some cases will be limited, and if after the closing date entries are over-subscribed, it will operate on a first come first served basis. Waiting lists will be kept for all over-subscribed classes. Classes may start early and might also run into the evening

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and remain the responsibility of the owner.

Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that the grounds of the venue are kept clean and litter put in the bins provided. Competitors are asked to remove any hay, bedding or muck from the lorry park prior to leaving the venue.

The organiser reserves the right to ask any person in breach of these terms and conditions, to leave the venue immediately.
